

VETCAP STORAGE & USEAGE CONDITIONS

The VetCap™ is a purpose designed gelatin capsule and is sensitive to environmental conditions. Performance may be impaired if storage and usage instructions are not followed correctly.

Storage Conditions (sealed packaging)

- Storage conditions AiM-L VetCaps: temperatures kept between relative humidity 30%- 50% and 50°F-70°F.
- Storage conditions AiM-A VetCaps: temperatures kept between relative humidity 30%- 70% and 50°F-80°F.
- **NEVER** freeze or refrigerate VetCaps, this may permanently damage them and make them unusable.
- Keep VetCaps in their sealed packaging until ready to use.
- VetCaps can become permanently damaged, brittle and break if exposed to low or freezing temperatures.
- If VetCaps are exposed to extremely high heat and humidity they may be damaged permanently and may not fragment properly: AiM-L can become too soft and bounce off the animal, and AiM-A may burst in the barrel or when discharged.

Usage Conditions

Actual pasture usage conditions may differ from recommended storage conditions noted above:

- Keep VetCaps at above mentioned storage conditions right up until ready to use.
- When ready to apply, always transport VetCaps in original sealed packaging. If needed, a cooler bag can be used during transportation.
- Do not chill VetCaps prior to application.
- In the field, only remove VetCaps from sealed packaging and load VetGun when ready to apply.
- Do not expose VetCaps to conditions contrary to the label storage recommendations (sealed or unsealed) for any extended periods of time or this may affect performance or level of fragmentation.
- For optimum results with AiM-A (green) VetCaps, the Mylar packaging should be opened exposing the VetCaps to warm, moist air for approximately 30-60 minutes prior to use.
- If exposed to high heat or humidity for extended periods, and become faulty, in some cases they may be able to be restored, see below.
- Take time to read all label information before use.

Restoring Conditions for impaired VetCaps

VetCaps stored contrary to label instructions and are not fragmenting on the animal ('bouncing'), or are breaking in the barrel; may be capable of some degree of restoring as follows:

Expose for up to 24 hours to conditions where relative humidity is 30%-50% and temperatures 50°F-80°F.

Repack and seal in original packaging, and keep in above recommended storage conditions.

Use as soon as possible and in accordance with above usage conditions.

ALWAYS KEEP VETCAPS AWAY FROM CHILDREN & ANIMALS.

Always read the full label and instructions before use.
